# I. THE PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

## 1. OVERALL OBJECTIVE

The objective of the "TWITEHO AMAGARA Y'UMUKENYEZI N'IKIBONDO" project is to promote the maternal and child health of pregnant and vulnerable women in Rusaka Commune in Mwaro Province.

## 2. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE

The specific objective of the "TWITEHO AMAGARA Y'UMUKENYEZI N'IKIBONDO" project is to raise awareness, mobilize, supervise and train through seminars on family planning, on natal consultations (CPN/CPON), on assisted deliveries in structures Health on Infant and Young Child Nutrition IYCF.

# II. ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The action plan of the "TWITEHO AMAGARA Y'UMUKENYEZI N'IKIBONDO" project developed together with the provincial and health authorities focuses on the following strategic axes:

### **III. ACHIEVEMENTS**

#### **STRATEGIC AXIS I:**

#### **IMPROVING THE PROVISION OF MATERNAL HEALTH CARE AND SERVICES, NEWBORN, CHILDREN, ADOLESCENTS AND YOUNG PEOPLE, THE ELDERLY, AS WELL AS QUALITY NUTRITIONAL HEALTH**

- Through weekly training seminars, 50 vulnerable pregnant women and their partners were made aware and trained on Prenatal Consultation, Postnatal Consultation and healthy childbirth: 28 training seminars were provided:
- 28 training seminars were organized and delivered for 50 vulnerable pregnant women, including 7 training seminars were organized and delivered for 50 vulnerable pregnant women and their spouses.

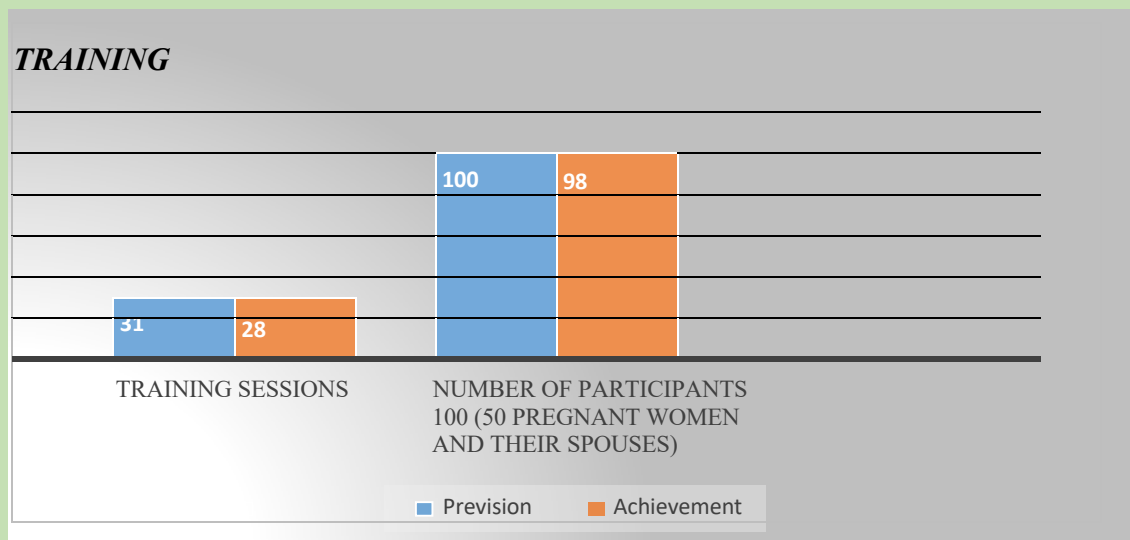
49 of the project beneficiaries (women and their spouses) out of 50 registered at the start of the project followed and completed the training sessions, only one couple dropped out before the end of the project, thus 98%.

### Graphical interpretation 1: Formation

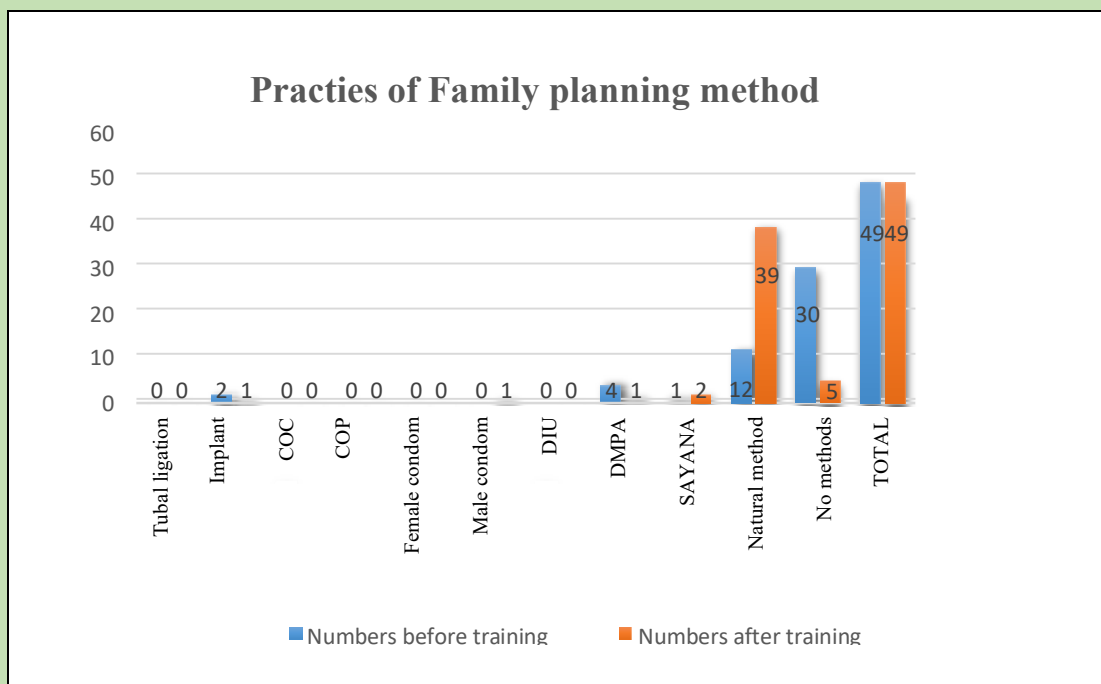
- 28 training sessions were provided out of 31 sessions planned

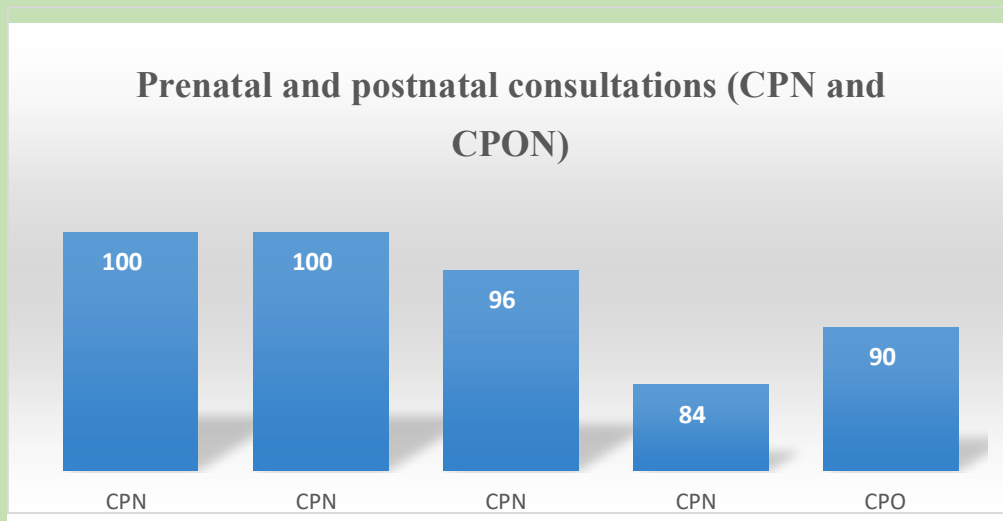
- 12 women used the natural method before the training. After training, 39 women adopted this method as a means of contraception
- 30 women did not use any contraceptive method before the training. Only 5 of these women did not adopt this contraceptive method after the training.

**Figure 3 interpretation : CPN1, CPN2, CPN3, CPN4 and CPON**

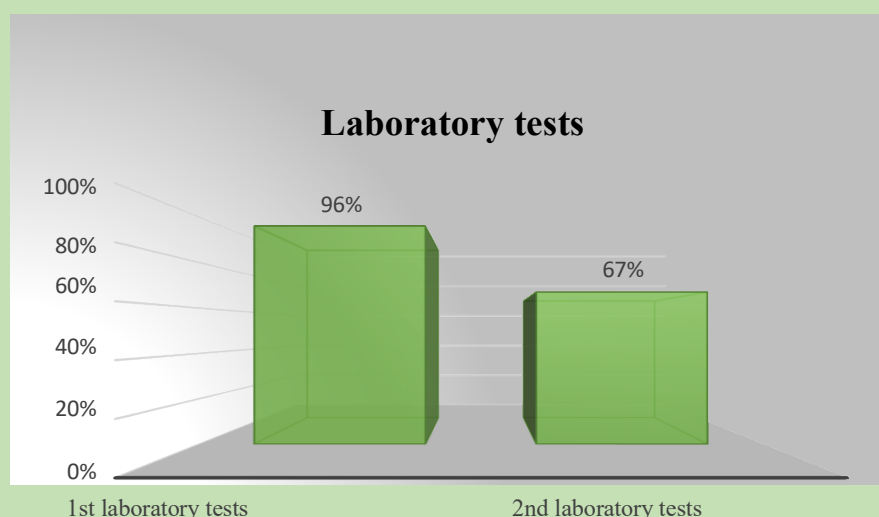
- 100% of pregnant women were able to benefit from two prenatal consultations (CPN1,CPN2)
- 96% of pregnant women had a third prenatal consultation (CPN3)
- 84% of pregnant women had a 4th prenatal consultation (CPN4)
- 90% of pregnant women benefited from a postnatal consultation (CPON)

**Figure 4 interpretation: Laboratory tests**

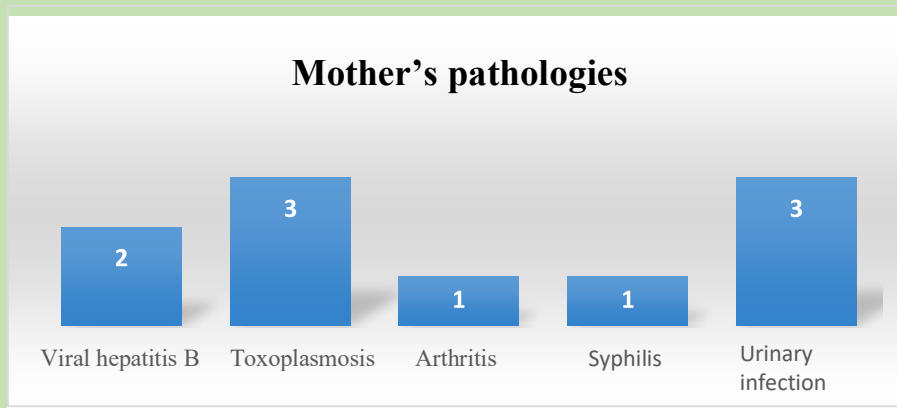
- 96% of beneficiaries completed the first laboratory examinations

- The most recurrent pathologies are Toxoplasmosis (3 cases) as well as urinary infections (3 cases)
- Third comes hepatitis B (2 cases)

**Figure 6: Obstetric ultrasounds**

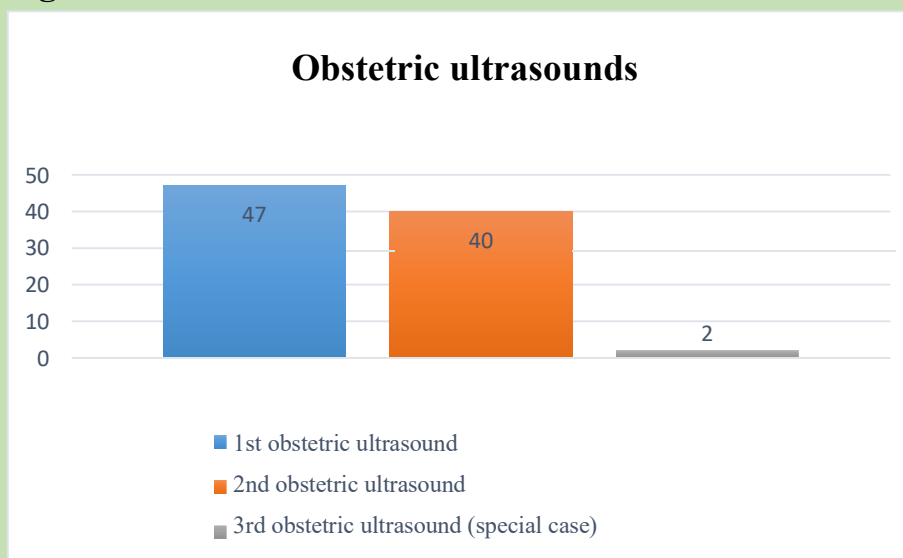


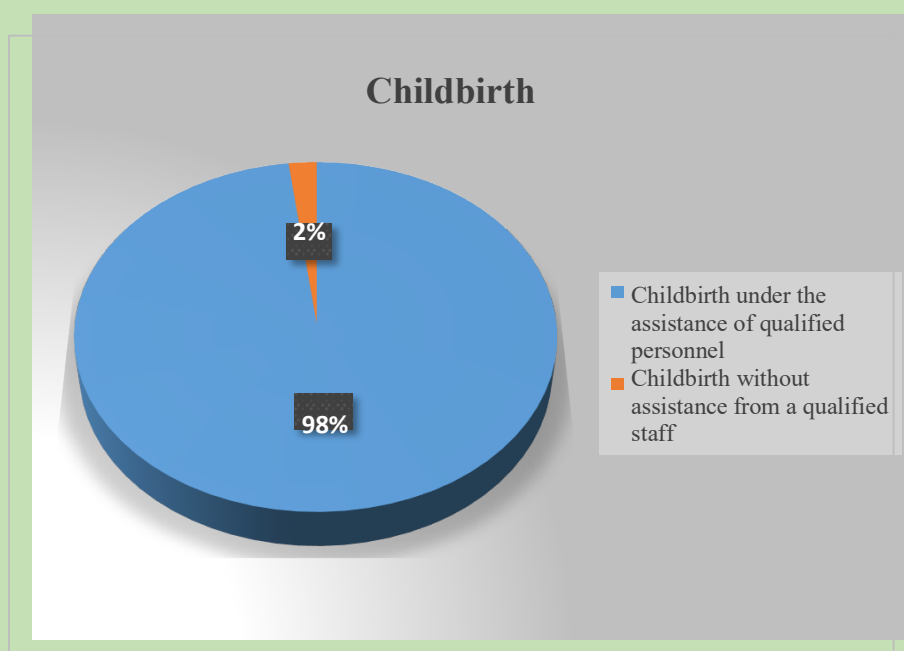
Figure 6 interpretation :

**Figure 7 interpretation : Childbirth**

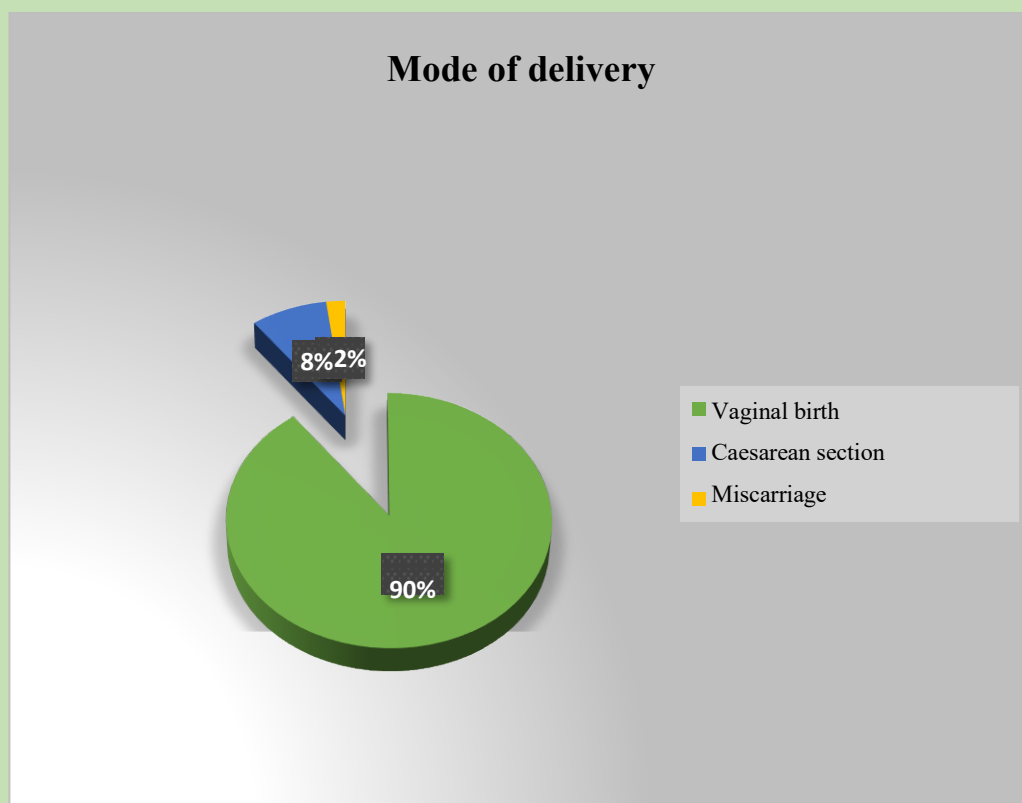
- 98% of women beneficiaries of the project gave birth under the assistance of qualified personnel

**Figure 8 : Mode of delivery**



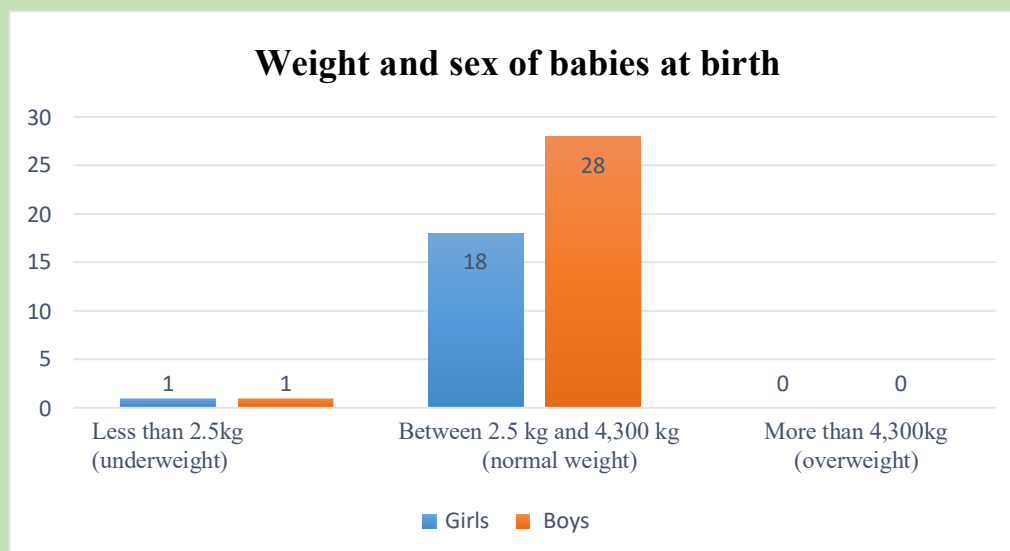

**Figure 9 : Weight and sex of babies at birth**



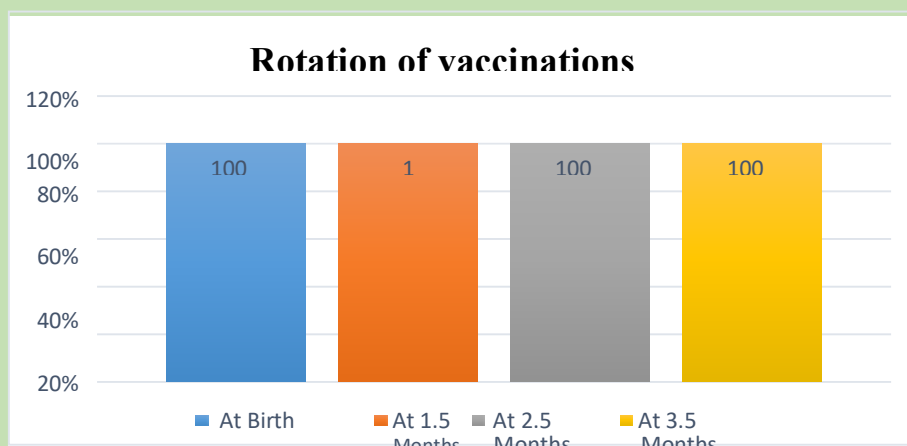
**Figure 9 interpretation : Weight and sex of babies at birth**

- 32 out of 32 children aged 2 and a half months and over received a 3rd vaccine
- 25 out of 25 children aged 3 and a half months and over received a 4th vaccine

The objective of this module is to contribute to improving the nutritional health of mothers and children: nutritional balance, the causes and consequences of an unbalanced diet.

- Development of small vegetable fields (akarima k'igikoni) in all 50 beneficiary households.
- Distribution of vegetable seeds to 50 beneficiaries.
- Change in mentality towards their old eating habits
- Consumption of vegetables.

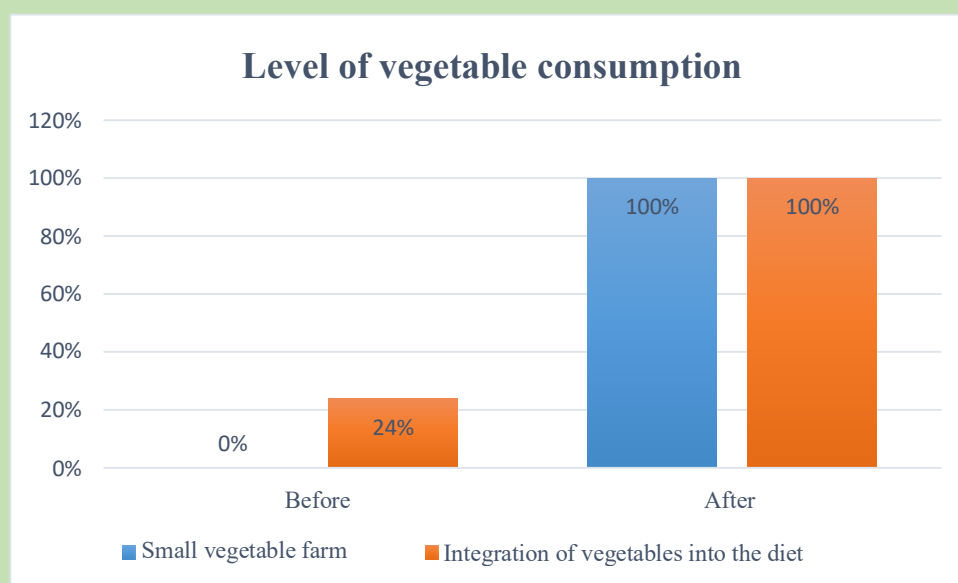

- 50 beneficiary households of the project improved their nutritional health through the consumption of vegetables.

During the month of August 2022, a planning meeting & development of the strategic plan was carried out in collaboration with the Provincial doctor's office, the Fota District Doctor's office, the Rusaka Health Center, and the municipal administration.

A follow-up meeting for the validation of the annual action plan was organized and the annual action plan was approved by the authorized authorities.

#### **Result XII. 1: Family behavior regarding fertility has changed**

The 50 women beneficiaries of the project were trained on hygiene.

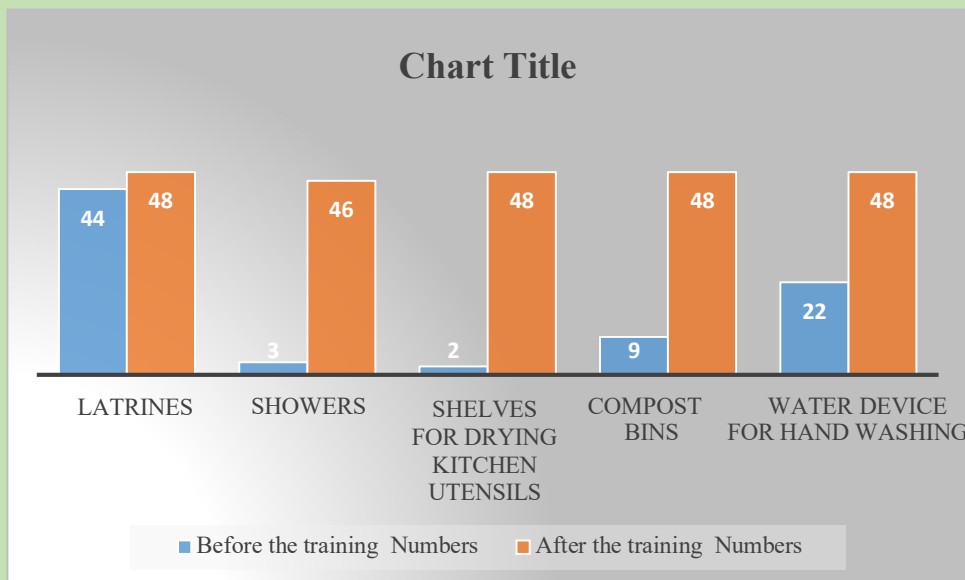
The objective of the module aims to provide vulnerable pregnant women and their spouses with knowledge about personal, food and environmental hygiene in order to cope with diseases due to lack of hygiene (diarrheal diseases, infections, skin diseases, etc.).

- Construction of 48 latrines in the households of project beneficiaries.
- Installation of 48 compost bins in the households of project beneficiaries.
- Arrangement of the 48 showers

- 48 out of 49 beneficiaries put into practice the knowledge acquired during hygiene training by setting up latrines in their homes (48), shelves for drying kitchen utensils (48), compost bins, as well as devices for washing hands (48).
- Of the 49 beneficiaries, 46 have already installed shower facilities in their homes (46) following the recommendations.

## **IV. CONCLUSION**

Although the project was successful, it encountered challenges during the implementation of the project:

- A long distance for beneficiaries to travel to access the medical care center : the distance to travel to the CDS varies from 1 to 9km (from Rusaka hill to Mpumbu hill).
- An absence of a nearby neonatal and pediatric care center for cases of high-risk or premature birth.
